

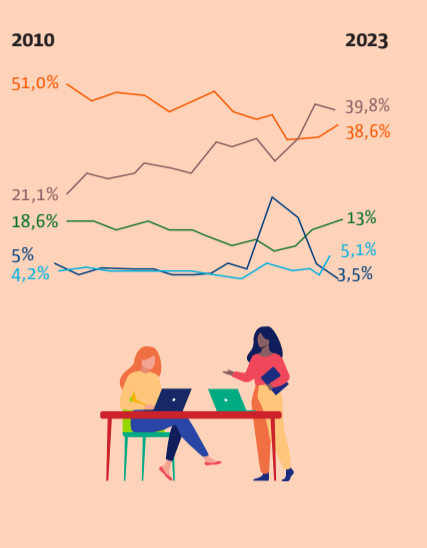

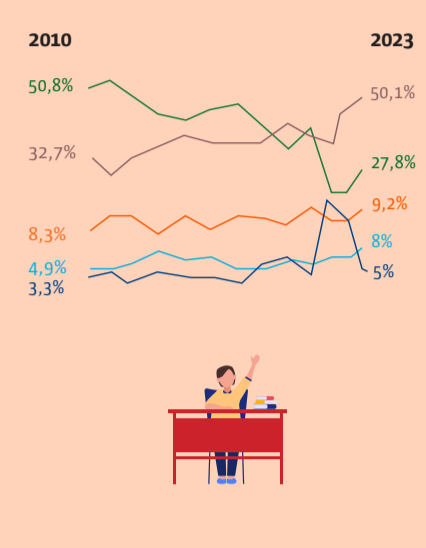


The modal split of the people of Antwerp in 2023

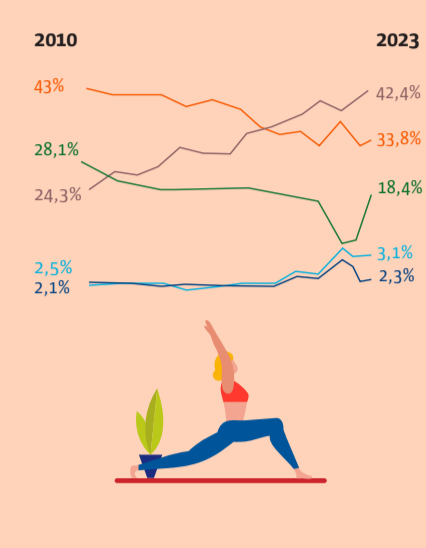

We shared mobility in 2023

In 2023, all shared mobility together represented almost **10 million** journeys.

Antwerp companies have switched to smart mobility

The city of Antwerp had a close collaboration with **147** Antwerp based employers in 2023, accounting for a total of **71.183** employees. Smart ways to Antwerp carried out a comprehensive mobility scan among **8** companies in 2023, receiving responses from **2.629** employees.



In 2023, **631** employees from **31** different companies comprehensively tested alternative means of transport during a 1-month trial period. The majority subsequently opted for sustainable travel in the future.
